AN ACT PROVIDING FOR A COST OF LIVING ADJUSTMENT FOR KENNETH T. RAINEY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 712 of the acts of nineteen hundred and eighty-one is
- 2 hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following
- 3 sentence: Said pension shall be subject to the cost of living
- 4 adjustments for the year nineteen hundred and eighty-seven and
- 5 every year thereafter.
