AN ACT CLARIFYING FILING AND PUBLICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR STATE AGENCY REGULATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 3A of chapter 30A as appearing in the
2 1984 Official Edition of the General Laws is hereby amended by
3 striking the second sentence.

1 SECTION 2. Section 6 of chapter 30A as appearing in the 1984
2 Official Edition of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking
3 the second sentence in the fourth paragraph and inserting in place
4 the following: — Emergency regulations shall become effective
5 when filed with the state secretary, or at such later time as may
6 be required by law or be specified therein, and shall remain in
7 effect no longer than three months following filing except as
8 provided in sections two and three.
