AN ACT EXCUSING MUNICIPALITIES FROM PAYMENT OF MASSACHUSETTS BAY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY ASSESSMENTS IN CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The first sentence of section 143 of chapter 161A
2 of the General Laws, as appearing in section 18 of chapter 563
3 of the acts of 1964, is hereby amended by inserting after the word
4 "passengers", in line 2, the words: —; provided, however, that no
5 assessment under this section shall be made against any such city
6 or town which, in the opinion of the advisory board, derives no
7 direct benefit from local service provided by the authority.

1 SECTION 2. The first sentence of section 147 of said chapter
2 161A, as so appearing, is hereby amended by inserting after the
3 word "necessary", in line 9, the words: — provided, however, that
4 no assessment under this section shall be made against any such
5 city or town which, in the opinion of the advisory board, derives
6 no direct benefit from local service provided by the authority.

By the Ministry of Education, Department of Higher Education, and
