AN ACT FORBIDDING THE USE OF 03/07 CONSULTANT/CONTRACTORS UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 29A of Chapter 29 of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by adding thereto the following new paragraph:
- 3 "Service rendered under an 03/07 contract must be a service
- 4 which employees of the commonwealth do not render in the
- 5 ordinary course of their employment in carrying out the duties
- 6 of their titles and specifications as established by the director of
- 7 personnel administration under chapter thirty."
