AN ACT RELATIVE TO COLLECTIVE BARGAINING BY HOUSING AUTHORITIES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 29, of Chapter 121B, as most recently amended by  
2 Chapter 393, of the Acts of 1978, is hereby further amended by  
3 the deletion of the fourth paragraph, and insertion in place  
4 thereof, the following: —

5 “Notwithstanding any provision of the law to the contrary, the  
6 provisions of Chapter 150 E, and the rules and regulations  
7 promulgated thereunder, except paragraphs (a) (b) and (c) of  
8 Section 7, shall apply to said housing authorities and their  
9 employees. Any collective bargaining agreement, reached between  
10 the authority and the exclusive representative, as defined in said  
11 Chapter 150 E, shall not exceed the term of three years. The  
12 agreement shall be reduced to writing, executed by the parties and  
13 submitted to the department by the authority, together with a  
14 request for appropriation necessary to fund the cost items  
15 contained therein. If the department rejects said request for the  
16 appropriation necessary to fund the cost items, such cost items  
17 shall be returned to the parties for further bargaining.”
