AN ACT RELATING TO CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF SCHOOL COMMITTEES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

REPORT OF THE BOARD OF REGENTS

FOR THE YEAR 1902

The Board of Regents of the University of California, at its meeting held at Berkeley, California, on the 10th day of June, 1902, has the honor to report to the Legislature the results of its operations during the year 1902. The Board has the pleasure to announce that the University has during the year 1902, under the able and efficient management of the President, Mr. D. D. Johnson, and the assistance of the Faculty, made great progress in all its departments. The total enrollment for the year 1902 was 1,100 students, an increase of 100 over the enrollment for the year 1901. The total amount of the State appropriation for the year 1902 was \$1,000,000, an increase of \$100,000 over the appropriation for the year 1901. The Board has the honor to recommend that the Legislature appropriate for the year 1903 the sum of \$1,100,000 for the support of the University of California.
