

HOUSE No. 1932

By Mr. Correia of Fall River, petition of Robert Correia, Thomas C. Norton, Charles E. Silvia, Joan M. Menard and Albert Herren relative to the abatement of taxes of certain property destroyed by fire in the city of Fall River on January twelfth of the current year. Taxation.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ABATEMENT OF TAXES CAUSED BY A FIRE IN THE CITY OF FALL RIVER ON JANUARY TWELVE, NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of sections two A
2 and thirty-eight of chapter fifty-nine of the General Laws, the board
3 of assessors of the city of Fall River may for the fiscal year begin-
4 ning July first, nineteen hundred and eighty-seven determine the
5 valuation of property destroyed by the fire of January twelve,
6 nineteen hundred and eighty-seven, immediately subsequent to said
7 fire for the purposes of granting abatements applied for under
8 section fifty-nine of said chapter fifty-nine.

9 The commissioner of revenue is hereby authorized to reimburse
10 said city of Fall River for any abatements granted pursuant to the
11 provisions of this section from funds appropriated therefore.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
