RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO VOTER ELIGIBILITY IN PARTY PRIMARIES IN ORDER TO ESTABLISH ADMINISTRATIVE METHODS FOR PRIMARY ENROLLMENT.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of three
2 members of the senate, three members of the house of
3 representatives, and three persons to be appointed by the
4 governor, is hereby established for the purpose of making an
5 investigation and study into the eligibility of certain voters to
6 participate in party primaries in order to establish an appropriate
7 administrative method for voters to enroll in a party prior to
8 voting in party primaries and to provide notice to voters of their
9 current enrollment status.
