AN ACT AUTHORIZING FRANCIS T. FALLON TO TAKE AN OPEN COMPETITIVE CIVIL SERVICE EXAMINATION FOR POLICE OFFICER NOTWITHSTANDING THE MAXIMUM AGE REQUIREMENTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any law or  
2 rule to the contrary regulating the maximum age of applicants  
3 for appointment as a police officer, Francis T. Fallon shall be  
4 eligible to take the next open competitive entrance examination  
5 for police officer in the town of Middleboro and, provided he  
6 meets all other requirements, shall be eligible for certification and  
7 appointment as a police officer in the town of Middleboro.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
