An Act authorizing francis T. Fallon to take an open competitive civil service examination for police officer notwithstanding the maximum age requirements.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any law or 2 rule to the contrary regulating the maximum age of applicants
- 3 for appointment as a police officer, Francis T. Fallon shall be
- 4 eligible to take the next open competitive entrance examination
- 5 for police officer in the town of Middleboro and, provided he
- 6 meets all other requirements, shall be eligible for certification and
- 7 appointment as a police officer in the town of Middleboro.
- 1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
