

ACTS, 1980. - Chaps. 426, 427.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section one hundred and forty-two A of chapter two hundred and eleven of the General Laws or the provisions of any other law, rule or regulation to the contrary, products of open space land husbandry and management, including materials commonly referred to as brush, including vegetation such as tree branches, brush cane, driftwood and other forestry debris, but excluding grass, hay or leaves, may be burned at the landfill site of Nantucket county, situated off Madaket road in said town, from January first to January thirty-first, both dates inclusive; from March first to March thirty-first, both dates inclusive; from May first to May thirty-first, both dates inclusive; from July first to July thirty-first, both dates inclusive; from September first to September thirtieth, both dates inclusive; and from November first to November thirtieth, both dates inclusive; provided, however, that such burning shall be performed with the approval of the county commissioners of said county, but the supervision of any such burning may be delegated by said commissioners.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap. 426. AN ACT EXCLUDING CERTAIN FEDERAL FUNDS IN COMPUTING THE TOTAL AMOUNT AUTHORIZED TO CONSTRUCT AND EQUIP A COURTHOUSE IN THE CITY OF FITCHBURG.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The second paragraph of section 1 of chapter 314 of the acts of 1976, as amended by section 1 of chapter 515 of the acts of 1978, is hereby further amended by striking out the second sentence.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
