AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE EMERGENCY MEDICAL CARE ADVISORY BOARD TO ADOPT REGULATIONS RELATIVE TO EMERGENCY LIGHTING SIGNALS ON MOTOR VEHICLES USED BY DIVERS AND OTHER RESCUE WORKERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 7 of chapter 111C of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by adding the following paragraph: —
- 3 The board shall also adopt regulations permitting divers and
- 4 other rescue team members certified as such by the police chief
- 5 of a city or town to deploy emergency lighting signals on motor
- 6 vehicles used by them to reach the scene of an emergency.
