AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE COMPUTATION OF VACATION AND SICK LEAVE FOR CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, any
2 person employed by the Department of Public Health on the
3 effective date of this act shall be deemed to have been so employed
4 for the purposes of determining accrued vacation and sick leave
5 for any prior period between January 1, 1970 and December 7,
6 1986 during which such person was paid by the American Lung
7 Association for services rendered at the Mycobacteriology
8 Laboratory, so called, located at the Mattapan Hospital or the
9 State Laboratory Institute.
