AN ACT PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES FOR PERSONS CONVICTED OF CERTAIN CRIMES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 266 of the General Laws as most recently amended is
2 hereby further amended by inserting after section 5A, the follow-
3 ing new section: —

4 “Section 5B. Whoever wilfully and maliciously steals, destroys
5 or otherwise damages farm property, livestock or crops shall be
6 punished by a fine equal to three times the fair market value of the
7 property, livestock or crops so stolen or destroyed or damaged.”
