AN ACT REQUIRING KNOWLEDGE OF THE PENALTIES FOR OPERATING A MOTOR VEHICLE WHILE DRIVING UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF INTOXICATING LIQUORS BY APPLICANTS FOR A LICENSE TO OPERATE A MOTOR VEHICLE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 8 of Chapter 90 of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended by Chapter 110 of the Acts of 1980, is hereby further
3 amended in the first paragraph by inserting after the first sentence
4 the following new sentence: — Said examination shall include,
5 but not be limited to, such questions as the registrar may deter-
6 mine, which demonstrate an applicant's knowledge of the provi-
7 sions of Sections 23 through 24J inclusive of Chapter 90 of the
8 General Laws.
