AN ACT RELATIVE TO SCHOOL BUS MONITORS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 71 of the Massachusetts General Laws is hereby
2 amended by adding the following section after section 7C;

3 *Section 7D.* The state treasurer shall annually, on or before
4 November first, pay to the several towns subject to appropriation,
5 the sums required as reimbursement for expenses approved by the
6 Commissioner of education for the payment of school bus
7 monitors. Said payment shall not be more than one-half of the
8 actual cost of providing school bus monitors at a rate of one school
9 bus monitor per school bus which has a seating capacity of 10 or
10 more students and is used to transport students in grades K1
11 through grade 3.

12 School bus monitors shall be provided for on the list of jobs to
13 be performed under each bidder's contract and their rate of
14 compensation shall be determined, at the request of the city or
15 town awarding the contract, by the COMMISSIONER of Labor
16 and Industries.
