AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT FUND.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The first paragraph of section 51 of chapter 15 of the General
- 2 Laws, as inserted by section 6 of chapter 188 of the acts of 1985,
- 3 is hereby amended by striking out lines 12 and 13 and inserting
- 4 in place thereof the following words: — year multiplied by fifty
- 5 dollars in the fiscal year nineteen hundred and eighty-eight and
- 6 increasing this amount by five per cent each fiscal year thereafter.
