AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE QUALIFICATION OF SPECIAL NEEDS ADMINISTRATOR.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 71B of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 inserting after section 3 the following section: —

3 Section 3A. No school committee shall appoint an administra-
4 tor of special education unless it is clearly demonstrated that said
5 administrators has a complete knowledge of all areas of special
6 needs including, but not limited to, the extent and types of
7 disabilities, their symptoms and all available education remedies
8 and institutions.
