AN ACT REGULATING THE RIGHT OF CERTAIN PERSONS TO PARTICIPATE IN RENT SUBSIDY PROGRAMS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 20 of chapter 268A of the General Laws, is hereby
2 amended by inserting after (g), the words, "or (h) to a municipal
3 employee who is the owner of residential rental property and rents
4 such property to a tenant receiving a rental subsidy administered by
5 a local housing authority, unless the employee is employed by such
6 local housing authority in a capacity in which he has responsibility
7 for the administration of such subsidy programs."
