RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE COMMISSION OF THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE SAFETY OF THE JAMAICAWAY IN BOSTON.

1 *Resolved*, That the Commissioner of the Metropolitan District
2 Commission is hereby directed to conduct an investigation and
3 study in the safety of the Jamaica way in Boston.

4 Said Commissioner shall determine the traffic count at peak
5 hours; the number of car accidents on said road; the reasons and
6 circumstances surrounding these accidents, the feasibility of
7 reducing the curves in said road through construction; the
8 feasibility of constructing a safety divider in the middle of said
9 road; the feasibility of reducing the number of lanes from two to
10 one in each direction; and any such measure which might reduce
11 traffic accidents on said road.

12 Said Commissioner shall file his report to the General Court
13 containing the results of his investigation and study, and his
14 recommendations, if any, by December thirty-first, nineteen
15 hundred and eighty-seven.
