AN ACT FURTHER DEFINING FAMILY ABUSE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1 of chapter 209A of the General Laws, as appearing in
- 2 the 1984 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out lines 11
- 3 and 12 and inserting in place thereof the following: —
- 4 “Family or household member,” household member, former
- 5 household member, spouse, former spouse of their minor children
- 6 or blood relative.
