### AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE USE OF MOTORIZED BICYCLES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 1B of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in  
2 the 1984 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the  
3 following paragraph: —

4 Every person operating a motorized bicycle or riding as a  
5 passenger on a motorized bicycle shall wear protective headgear  
6 conforming with such minimum standards of construction and  
7 performance as the registrar may prescribe, and no person  
8 operating a motorized bicycle shall permit any other person to  
9 ride as a passenger on such motorized bicycle unless such  
10 passenger is wearing such protective head gear.

11 All motorized bicycles shall be entitled to full use of a lane on  
12 a road or highway and no motor vehicle shall be operated in such  
13 a manner as to intentionally deprive any motorized bicycle of full  
14 use of such lane.
