AN ACT ALLOWING TAXPAYERS TO DIVERT CERTAIN TAX CREDITS TO BE USED FOR SHELTERS FOR HOMELESS PERSONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Clause (1) of subsection (b) of section 6 of chapter 62 of the
2 General Laws, as most recently amended by section 2A of chapter
3 577 of the acts of 1980, is hereby further amended by adding the
4 following sentence: — A taxpayer entitled to a credit under the
5 provisions of this clause may elect, in lieu of receipt thereof, to
6 direct the commissioner to forward the amount of such credit to the
7 commissioner of public welfare who shall aggregate such amounts
8 annually and apply them to the maintenance of shelters for home-
9 less persons.
