2 members of the senate, seven members of the house of
3 representatives, the sheriff of Suffolk County or his designee, the
4 sheriff of Hampden county or his designee, and five persons to
5 be appointed by the Governor, one of whom shall be a constable,
6 is hereby established for the purpose of making an investigation
7 and study relative to existing rules and regulations concerning
8 service of process by constables and deputy sheriffs.
