By Mr. Marsh of Wellesley, petition of Robert H. Marsh for legislation to prohibit the hiring of a state employee before his job has been authorized. Public Service.

AN ACT PROHIBITING THE HIRING OF A STATE EMPLOYEE BEFORE HIS JOB HAS BEEN AUTHORIZED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 30 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
2 after section 25A the following section: —

3 Section 25B. No person shall be engaged by any department of
4 the commonwealth, including the legislative branch thereof unless
5 such job has been authorized and the money funded therefor as
6 determined by the commissioner of administration and finance.
7 Whoever violates any provision of this section shall be punished by
8 a fine of one thousand dollars.
