The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Seven.

1 *Ordered*, That the committee on Commerce and Labor shall be
2 authorized to sit during the recess of the General Court for the
3 purpose of making an investigation and study relative to Unem-
4 ployment Compensation Laws in the Commonwealth.

5 Said committee shall be provided with quarters in the State
6 House or elsewhere, may hold public hearings, may travel within
7 the Commonwealth, and may expend for clerical and other services
8 and expenses such sums as may be appropriated therefor. Said
9 committee shall report to the General Court the results of its
10 investigation and study and its recommendations, if any together
11 with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such recommendations
12 into effect by filing the same with the Clerk of the House of
13 Representatives on or before the first Wednesday in November,
14 nineteen hundred and eighty-seven.
