AN ACT CONCERNING THE BOARD OF REGISTRATION OF PSYCHOLOGISTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of section five of chapter one
2 thousand twenty-two of the acts of nineteen hundred and seventy-
3 one, or any other law or regulation to the contrary, to correct an
4 inequity, the board of registration of psychologists is hereby
5 authorized and directed to license Harry S. Levitan of Milton
6 without an examination.
