AN ACT RELATIVE TO REPRESENTATION ON THE CONVENTION AUTHORITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Paragraph two of Section 33 of the Acts and Resolves of 1982
2 shall be changed by replacing the first three sentences with the
3 following:

4 Section 33. The Authority shall consist of at least seven
5 members, who shall be appointed as provided hereunder. Four
6 members shall be appointed by the governor and two members
7 shall be appointed by the mayor. The remaining member shall be
8 the treasurer and receiver-general of the Commonwealth, who
9 shall also serve as Chairman. In addition, a representative from
10 the hotel industry shall be appointed from each city with
11 properties or facilities under the control of the Authority, to be
12 appointed by the mayor of that city and to serve staggered terms
13 as designated by the chairman but in no event to be less than two
14 years.
