AN ACT TO AMEND THE CIVIL SERVICE LAW.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 43 of Chapter 31 of the Massachusetts General Laws
- 2 is hereby amended by placing a comma after the words appointing
- 3 authority and by inserting the following new language:
- 4 but may not increase the penalty imposed by the appointing
- 5 authority.
