### AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATION TO REIMBURSE CERTAIN TOWNS FOR COMPLYING WITH A STATE MANDATE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 For the purpose of reimbursing certain towns for costs incurred  
2 in complying with a regulation of the department of environmen-  
3 tal quality engineering concerning the operation of sanitary  
4 landfills there is hereby appropriated from the General Fund the  
5 following amounts.
