AN ACT RELATIVE TO WEAPONS CARRIED ON HIGH SCHOOL GROUNDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Subsection J of Section 10 of Chapter 269 of the General Laws as
2 most recently amended by Chapter 516 of the Acts of 1983 is
3 hereby further amended by inserting the words "secondary school"
4 after the word "university" in lines four and five and by adding at
5 the end thereof the following sentence: —
6 Any officer in charge of a college or university or secondary
7 school, any faculty member or administrative officer of a college or
8 university or secondary school failing to report violations of this
9 subsection shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and punished by a fine
10 of not more than five hundred dollars.
