AN ACT TO ENSURE THE REPAYMENT BY STATE EMPLOYEES OF MASSACHUSETTS GUARANTEED STUDENT LOANS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 15C of the General Laws is amended by  
2 adding after section 26, the following new section: —

3 Section 26A. The Massachusetts Higher Education Assistance  
4 Corporation and the New England Loan Marketing Corporation  
5 shall report to the Department of Revenue by September 30 of  
6 each calendar year, the names of those state employees that have  
7 been in default of repayment of Massachusetts granted guaranteed  
8 student educational loans for a period of one year.

1 SECTION 2. Pursuant to section 3 of chapter 62D of the  
2 Massachusetts General Laws, the Department of Revenue shall  
3 assist the Massachusetts Higher Education Assistance Corpora-  
4 tion and the New England Loan Marketing Corporation in the  
5 collection of the delinquent student loan repayments.
