The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Seven.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THE PAYING OF INTEREST ON MONIES OWED TO CERTAIN STATE EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 29 of the Massachusetts General Laws shall be amended
- 2 by adding the following section 31E: —
- 3 Three weeks following the date that the Legislature authorizes
- 4 and appropriates funds for state employees' salary increases, real-
- 5 locations, reclassifications, and/or upgradings, the Commonwealth
- 6 shall begin to pay daily interest at a rate equal to the average interest
- 7 rate of regular savings accounts in Massachusetts to all state
- 8 employees who have not received said appropriated funds for their
- 9 respective salary increase, reallocation, reclassification, and/or
- 10 upgrading until such time as they receive said funds.
