Webber for legislation to authorize the appropriation of a certain sum of money from the Local Aid Fund for the town of Williamstown for alleviation of certain financial burdens imposed on said town by the overflow of the Bee Hill Road Dam. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ALLEVIATION OF CERTAIN FINANCIAL BURDENS IMPOSED ON THE TOWN OF WILLIAMSTOWN BY THE OVERFLOW OF THE BEE HILL ROAD DAM IN SAID TOWN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 To provide for the purposes of disaster relief and to meet the
2 expenses of public services incurred during the overflow of the
3 Bee Hill Road dam in the town of Williamstown on August
4 seventeenth, nineteen hundred and eighty-six, the sum of two
5 hundred and five thousand, five hundred and sixty dollars is
6 hereby appropriated from the local aid fund. The secretary of
7 administration is hereby directed to grant two hundred and five
8 thousand, five hundred and sixty dollars to said town to meet the
9 expense of restoring and providing police, fire and public works
10 and other public services utilized by said town for the purposes
11 of aiding the overflow victims and maintaining the public ways
12 during the overflow of the Bee Hill Road dam in said town on
13 August seventeenth, nineteen hundred and eighty-six.
