AN ACT PREVENTING EVASION OF PARKING VIOLATION PENALTIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The seventh paragraph of section 20A of chapter
2 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the first
3 sentence and inserting in place thereof the following sentence: —
4 If any person fails to appear in accordance with said notice, the
5 parking clerk shall notify the registrar of motor vehicles who shall
6 place the matter on record and, upon receipt of two or more such
7 notices, shall not renew, swap, transfer, issue or re-issue the license
8 to operate a motor vehicle of the registered owner of the vehicle
9 or the registration of said vehicle or any other vehicle of said owner
10 until after notice from the parking clerk that all such matters have
11 been disposed of in accordance with law.

1 SECTION 2. The eighth paragraph of section 20A $\frac{1}{2}$ of said
2 chapter 90 is hereby amended by striking out the first sentence
3 and inserting in place thereof the following sentence: —
4 If any person fails to appear in accordance with said notice,
5 the parking clerk shall notify the registrar of motor vehicles who
6 shall place the matter on record and, upon receipt of two or more
7 such notices, shall not renew, swap, transfer, issue or re-issue the
8 license to operate a motor vehicle of the registered owner of the
9 vehicle or the registration of said vehicle or any other vehicle of
10 said owner until after notice from the parking clerk that all such
11 matters have been disposed of in accordance with law.

1 SECTION 3. Section 4C of Section 13B of chapter 190 of the
2 acts of 1982 is hereby amended by striking out the second sentence
3 and inserting in place therefor the following sentence: — If any
4 person fails to pay any parking violation notice within twenty-
5 one days or fails to appear in accordance with said hearing notice
6 the parking clerk shall notify the registrar of motor vehicles who
7 shall place the matter on record and not renew, swap, transfer,
8 issue or re-issue the license to operate a motor vehicle of the
9 registered owner of the vehicle or the registration of said vehicle
10 or any other vehicle of said owner until after notice from the
11 parking clerk that the matter has been disposed of in accordance
12 with law.
