AN ACT TO IMPROVE THE DEPARTMENT OF CAPITAL PLANNING AND OPERATIONS ABILITY TO CONTRACT WITH PRIVATE ENTITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Paragraph (3) of section 44C of chapter 149 of the General Laws
2 is hereby amended by striking out the first sentence and inserting
3 in place thereof the following sentence: — Debarment for a period
4 of between one and five years in the case of the first debarment
5 of a contractor, and for a period of at least five years in the case
6 of a contractor who has been previously debarred for any reason
7 within five years prior to the incident or incidents causing the
8 second debarment, shall be imposed for any of the following
9 causes:
