## **The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR DISTINCTIVE MOTOR VEHICLE PLATES FOR OFFICERS OF VFW POSTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 2 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as amended by  
2 chapter 308 of the acts of 1986, is hereby further amended by  
3 adding the following paragraph: —

4 The registrar shall furnish at his office at no less than cost to  
5 officers of veterans of foreign wars posts in the commonwealth  
6 plates bearing the initials VFW suitable for attachment to a motor  
7 vehicle owned solely or in part by such officers and registered  
8 under this chapter.

At the report of the Committee on the subject of the proposed amendments to the Constitution of the United States, the following amendments were reported and discussed:

**The Constitution of the United States**  
As proposed by the Committee on the subject of the proposed amendments to the Constitution of the United States

SECTION 1. All legislative powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.

SECTION 2. The House of Representatives shall be composed of Members chosen every second Year by the People of the several States, and the Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors of the most numerous Branch of the State Legislature.

SECTION 3. The Senate shall be composed of two Senators from each State, chosen by the Legislature thereof, for a Term of six Years; and each Senator shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors of the most numerous Branch of the State Legislature.

SECTION 4. The Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors of the most numerous Branch of the State Legislature.
