

HOUSE No. 4820

By Mr. Grenier of Spencer, petition of Henry R. Grenier for the appointment of a joint special committee to make an investigation and study relative to rent control for mobile home parks. Commerce and Labor.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Seven.

- 1 *Ordered*, That a Special Committee to consist of two members
2 of the Senate to be designated by the President thereof and five
3 members of the House of Representatives to be designated by the
4 Speaker thereof, be authorized to make an investigation and study
5 relative to general enabling rent control legislation for mobile
6 home parks or other necessary alternatives to the existing
7 problems created by a scarcity of mobile home parks, an
8 increasing shortage of mobile home spaces and the potential of
9 abnormally high rents for mobile home park accommodations.
- 10 Said commission shall be provided with quarters in the State
11 House or elsewhere, may hold public hearings, may travel within
12 or outside the Commonwealth, and may expend up to \$50,000.00
13 for appropriate expenses. Said commission shall report to the
14 General Court the results of its investigation and study, and its
15 recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation
16 necessary to carry its recommendations into effect, by filing the
17 same with the Clerk of the House on or before the last Wednesday
18 in January, nineteen hundred and eighty-seven.

By Mr. GARDNER of Vermont, (for the Vermont Delegation) a bill (H. R. 1810) for the purpose of providing for the relief of the estate of the late John G. Gardner, deceased, and for other purposes.
