## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Seven.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR COMPULSORY PUBLIC SERVICE FOR CERTAIN STUDENTS IN HIGHER EDUCATION PROGRAMS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 69 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
- 2 after section 31D the following section: —
- 3 Section 31E. Any student attending a state college or
- 4 university or any student who is receiving financial assistance from
- 5 any program funded by the commonwealth and who is attending
- 6 a private college or university as part of the curriculum of the state
- 7 college or university or as a condition of receiving such financial
- 8 assistance shall perform such compulsory public service as
- 9 prescribed by the department of education. Said department shall
- 10 establish a variety of programs throughout the commonwealth to
- 11 provide students with a wide range of opportunities to fulfill their
- 12 requirement.
