AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE RETURN OF MOTOR VEHICLE NUMBER PLATES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Provision (2) A of section 113A of chapter 175 of the General
- 2 Laws, as appearing in the 1984 Official Edition, is hereby amended
- 3 by adding the following paragraph: —
- 4 The company shall not issue a return premium upon
- 5 cancellation of the policy until the insured has presented to the
- 6 company a receipt or other document showing that he has
- 7 returned to the registry of motor vehicles the number plates
- 8 assigned to the motor vehicle. The company shall be responsible
- 9 for the return of such number plates to the registry of motor
- 10 vehicles and shall send notice to the insured demanding the return
- 11 of such number plates to the registry of motor vehicles.
