### AN ACT RELATIVE TO ASSISTANT DISTRICT ATTORNEYS IN THE HAMPDEN DISTRICT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 14 of Chapter 12 is hereby amended by deleting in Section  
2 14 the words "For the Hampden District, thirteen assistant district  
3 attorneys;" and inserting in place thereof, "For the Hampden  
4 District, fifteen assistant district attorneys."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That

SEC. 1. That the Secretary of the Interior
