AN ACT AUTHORIZING JOSEPH W. LONG OF SOUTH HADLEY TO HOLD AND RECEIVE COMPENSATION OF BOTH THE POSITIONS OF SELECTMAN OF SAID TOWN AND MAINTENANCE EMPLOYEE OF THE SOUTH HADLEY HOUSING AUTHORITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of section twenty of chapter
2 two hundred and sixty-eight A of the General Laws, or any other
3 general or a special law to the contrary, no such law shall prohibit
4 Joseph W. Long of South Hadley from holding the position of
5 selectman in said town and the position of maintenance employee
6 in the South Hadley housing authority, nor shall any such law
7 prohibit said Joseph Long from performing the duties of and
8 receiving the compensation provided for both such positions.
