

By Mr. Cahir of Bourne, petition of Thomas S. Cahir relative to the reinstatement of certain members of the retirement system. Public Service.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE REINSTATEMENT OF CERTAIN MEMBERS OF THE RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Paragraph (g) of subdivision 1 of section 5 of chapter 32 of the
2 General Laws, as appearing in the 1984 Official Edition, is hereby
3 amended by adding the following paragraph: —

4 Any member inactive of a retirement system who is receiving
5 a retirement allowance after over thirty years of active service may
6 elect to become reinstated as a member in service without his being
7 required to repay into the system the money received from the
8 date of his retirement to the date of his again becoming a member
9 in service.
