The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Seven.

AN ACT PROVIDING RELIEF TO CITIES AND TOWNS DAMAGED BY THE STORM OF JANUARY SECOND, NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. To provide for disaster relief and meet the
2 expenses of public services incurred as a result of the storm which
3 struck the commonwealth on January second, nineteen hundred
4 and eighty-seven, the sum set forth in section two is hereby
5 appropriated, subject to the provisions of law regulating the
6 disbursements of public funds and the conditions pertaining to
7 appropriations in chapter two hundred and six of the acts of
8 nineteen hundred and eighty-six.

1 SECTION 2.

EXECUTIVE OFFICE FOR ADMINISTRATION AND FINANCE

1597-3530 For the purpose of providing disaster relief relating to the damage caused by the storm which struck the commonwealth on January second, nineteen hundred and eighty-seven including but not limited to the clean-up, repair, rebuilding and restoration of beaches, shores, seawalls and roads, said assistance shall be limited to amounts set forth in a list prepared and maintained by the civil defense agency and office of emergency preparedness, and shall include the following amounts:
