The committee on Housing and Urban Development, to whom were referred the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 1534) of William Constantino, Jr., and Thomas P. White relative to agreements between the town of Clinton and the Metropolitan District Commission regulating the sewer treatment facility and the use of water by said town; the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 1539) of William Constantino, Jr., and Thomas P. White relative to the operation of the sewerage treatment facility in the town of Clinton by the Metropolitan District Commission; the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 1823) of Alfred E. Saggese, Jr., for an appropriation of funds for repairs to the sewage treatment plant at Deer Island operated by the Metropolitan District Commission; the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 2344) of Alfred E. Saggese, Jr., that the town of Winthrop be reimbursed by the Commonwealth for expenditures to protect said town from hazards related to sewage and refuse disposal at Deer Island; and the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 4833) of William Constantino, Jr., and Thomas P. White relative to the water supply for the town of Clinton from the Wachusett Reservoir, reports recommending that the accompanying order (House, No. 5507) ought to be adopted.
