Golden relative to a study by the Division of Waterways in the Department of Environmental Quality Engineering of the restoration of Strawberry Hill in the town of Hull; the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 360) of Mary Jeanette Murray and William B. Golden for legislation to authorize an environmental impact statement relative to the development of a marina in the town of Hull; and the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 4452) of Mary Jeanette Murray for an appropriation for certain erosion control work in the town of Hull, reports recommending that the accompanying order (House, No. 5513) ought to be adopted.

1     *Ordered*, That the committee on Natural Resources and  
2 Agriculture be authorized to make an investigation and study of  
3 the current house documents numbered 354, legislation  
4 authorizing the Division of Waterways to undertake a certain  
5 study in the town of Hull; 360, legislation to authorize an  
6 environmental impact statement relative to the development of  
7 a marina in the town of Hull; and 4452, legislation to make an  
8 appropriation for certain erosion control work in the town of  
9 Hull.

10     Said committee shall be provided with quarters in the state  
11 house or elsewhere, may hold hearings, may require by summons  
12 the attendance and testimony of witnesses, may travel within and  
13 without the commonwealth and may expend for expert, legal,  
14 clerical and other services and for the expenses such sums as may  
15 be appropriated therefore.

16     Said committee shall report to the general court from time to  
17 time the results of its investigations and study and its  
18 recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation  
19 necessary to carry its recommendations into effect, by filing the  
20 same with the clerk of the house of representatives on or before  
21 the first Wednesday of December, nineteen hundred and eighty-  
22 seven.
