AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE BIRTH RECORDS OF ADOPTED CHILDREN.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The first paragraph of section 1 of chapter 46 of the General
- 2 Laws, as appearing in the 1984 Official Edition, is hereby amended
- 3 by inserting after the first sentence the following sentence: — Each
- 4 town clerk shall receive or obtain and record the birth record of
- 5 all children adopted by residents of his city or town.
