AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE CLASSIFICATION OF SAILMAKER SHOPS FOR FIRE INSURANCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 175 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
- 2 after section 99B the following section: -
- 3 Section 99C. There shall be established a separate classifica-
- 4 tion for sailmaker shops for companies issuing policies or
- 5 contracts which insure against loss or damage by fire or by fire
- 6 and lightning to property or interests in the commonwealth.
