1 *Ordered*, That the committee on Commerce and Labor be
2 authorized to sit during the recess of the General Court to make
3 an investigation and study of House document numbered H. 3893,
4 relative to employment and training.

5 Said committee shall report to the General Court the results
6 of its investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any
7 together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such recom-
8 mendations into effect, by filing the same with the Clerk of the
9 House of Representatives on or before the last Wednesday in
10 December, nineteen hundred and eighty-seven.
