1 *Ordered*, That the committee on the Judiciary be authorized
2 to make an investigation and study on current House document
3 numbered, 339, relative to consumer protection.

4 Said committee shall be provided with quarters in the State
5 House or elsewhere, may hold hearings, may travel within the
6 Commonwealth and may expend for clerical and other services
7 such sums as may be appropriated therefor. Said Committee shall
8 report to the General Court the results of its investigation neces-
9 sary to carry such recommendations into effect by filing the same
10 with the Clerk of the House of Representatives on or before the
11 last Wednesday in December, nineteen hundred eighty-seven.
